**WHEREAS**, these brave officers face daily challenges and risks in the line of duty, demonstrating courage, professionalism, and selflessness in their service to others; and






**WHEREAS**, the Soledad Police Department continues its tireless effort to engage the community through pop-up events, community engagement, and Citizen Academies.




